This is to confirm that Robert S. Wright completed, in 1986-87, the requirements of a Certificate in Divorce Mediation involving two courses, a credit course and a continuing education course.

- Divorce Mediation Law, Theory and Practice - not assessed

The credit course was taught by Dr. John Benoit of Dalhousie University; the continuing education course by Annette Strug, a well known mediation practitioner and James Williams, a Nova Scotia Family Court judge. While we no longer have a formal record of the continuing education course or the one-time certificate program, the instructors' recall the program and Robert Wright's participation and we are confident that the credit course record which we have is sufficient to confirm the completion of the 2 course certificate program.

The late 1980's were a time of great interest in mediation in the Halifax area including a community dispute mediation demonstration project which I was involved in as a mediation trainer.
