"i would say the bulk of my work these days is focused on serving the mental health needs of the most underserved populations."




"for example, i run a treatment group for male identified victims of sexual violence because i believe that men's mental health issues and certainly men's victimizations has been dramatically underserved."

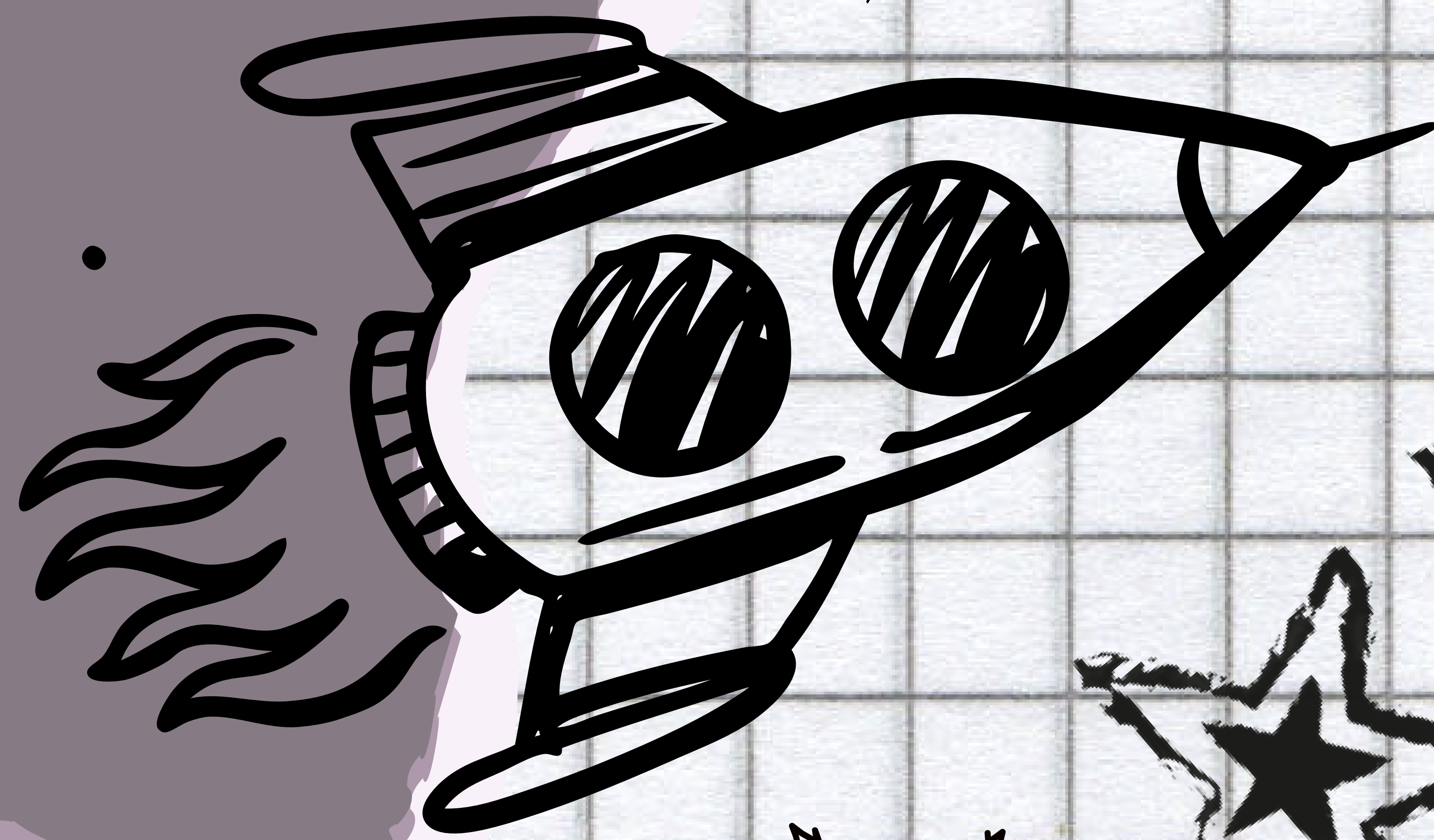
**"i would just remind everybody. that
